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2. How do we collect and process your information?

FES collect your Personally Identifiable Information as follows:

- Dealing with client/candidate via telephone, letter, e-mail, internet or a face-to-face meeting.
- Registering with us via our website.
- Submitting a CV via our website.
- Subscribing to any other communication form used by us.
- Submitting any information via our website in connection with an application.
- Information that is publicly available on Social Media platforms.

When we process your personal information we do this on the basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 under a, b or f EU Data Protection Regulation. If we process your personal information on the basis of Art. 6 paragraph 1 under f the legitimate interests we pursue are to enable us to offer clients the most suitable candidate for the respective position and to offer the best possible position to the candidates.

3. Why do we collect information?

We collect and process your information in order to be able to carry out our recruitment & selection or executive search services properly. We collect the information you choose to submit on our website or information that you choose to send to us via other communication tools such as e-mail or a face-to-face meeting. We may also collect information that is publicly available on social media platforms such as LinkedIn.

Based on the following *purposes* we might process the collected information:

Summarizing, we share personal data in all cases where we are legally obliged to do so (e.g. disclosure to the government or law enforcement agencies). We provide exclusively to third parties and only if this is necessary for the implementation of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. We share information from you as a candidate with our clients in case you have given an oral agreement.

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4. How long are personal data stored?

Please be informed that we do not store personal data longer than strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data are collected and based on legal requirements. We retain personal data as long as necessary for the processing purposes for which the personal data have been collected and all other permitted related purposes. When we no longer need personal data, we will irreversibly anonymize the data or destroy the data in a safe manner.

5. How do we protect this information?

FES takes the protection of your data seriously and takes appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized modification. Cookies

If you visit our website, we may track the visits using cookies. We note that FES uses technical, functional and analytical cookies that do not infringe your privacy. Cookies are packages of data that are stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit our website.
